CHILDREN IN WORSHIP

Young children are welcome to join in our worship. If you anticipate that your child cannot exercise the necessary self-control to remain still, please consider making good use of our training room out of consideration for others—particularly during the preaching of the Word.

CHANGES AT COVENANT

We are making several adjustments to our schedule and to the life of our church in upcoming weeks.

First, we will be phasing out the early service at the end of June, and beginning with two services only

(11:00am and 6:00pm) starting July 4th.

You will notice a few things that accompany this change. We’ve been worshiping apart for some months now, and you will be meeting new people over the next weeks, some of whom are long-time members (including elders and deacons who have attended either the early or later service, some rejoining the prayer rotation in evening worship) and others who are newer to Covenant. This will be an opportunity to increase your fellowship with other believers—use it well!

Second, we have returned to passing the offering plate in the worship service. If you are new to Covenant, you might notice that we do not have musical accompaniment during the offering. We understand the offering as an act of worship that stands on its own—a particular act of devotion to God. Use this time to meditate on God’s provision for you in every good thing.

Finally, we plan to celebrate the Lord’s Supper in July and August by continuing to come one by one to the table to receive the bread

and the wine. Our elders plan to distribute the elements throughout the congregation starting again in September.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

We are taking our regular summer break from Sunday School; we plan to return to our regular Sunday schedule August 29th.

CARRIAGE HOUSE MINISTRY

We are resuming our ministry at the Carriage House, an assisted living facility on Main Street in Taylors. This ministry was suspended in March 2020 due to COVID-related concerns. We are returning to our previous practice of holding a short service at the Carriage House each Lord's Day afternoon at 3 pm. Please see Jeremiah Mooney if you are able to help with this ministry.
