### **OUR PRESENT MOMENT**

Our weekly schedule has changed as we adjust to our new conditions:

First, the following activities have been suspended until further notice; monthly and mid-week fellowship meals, Sunday School (both for adults and children) and Wednesday night children's classes.

Second, we plan to continue our pattern of Wednesday night congregational prayer meeting, but online. Please look for details in an email sent later this week.

Third, our regular worship services will continue, morning and evening, both here at the church, in small groups throughout our region, and in individual homes. We have limited our gathering size at the church to a small group, large enough for a full worship service and key personnel to livestream these services.

We have not made these changes out of fear of disease or the fear of men. Rather, we are seeking to obev Christ's command to love our neighbor (especially the elderly, others particularly vulnerable to serious complications of COVID-19, and also our front line health care workers. We also respect the governing counsel of our authorities who face the difficult task of promoting the health of the citizens under their care, safeguarding our liberties and livelihoods at the same time.

In all of this we do are fully committed to the ongoing public worship of God, as our chief priority remains to glorify God and to enjoy Him forever.
